Onongua Enkhtur was born in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, on May 26, 1994. Since 2019, her research has focused on Land Art and Textile artworks. Gradually, she began working on performance art and installation projects. Today, her works are primarily focused on land and textile art, focusing on knitting, embroidery, weaving, and mixedmedia drawing techniques. Nevertheless, she also creates works of performance and installation art. She has initiated the Mongolian Trio Performance Art Group, "Neg-Uudel". Onongua Enkhtur began her artistic journey by painting, then moved on to textile, performance art, and installations. Her nomadic lifestyle is a significant influence on her artworks, with a focus on expressing the unique Mongolian culture that is closely tied to mother nature. In her latest works, Onongua aims to increase awareness about ecological changes caused by human activity, such as global warming and desertification.

We learn to cherish and protect what we have. The mane of the world means everything that exists in the world.






